College and University Student Update

As the college year for 2010-2011 ended in April, here are some the highlights and further prayer items for consideration.

The BFC distribution in January that was targeted towards college students at the McGill, Concordia, and UQAM metro stations, as well as a table at Concordia, resulted in 263 bibles distributed, 54 to students. Of this number, the team has regularly met with six students for appointments throughout the week. All the appointments have been very encouraging, as there has been much fellowship and enjoyment over the text and the footnotes of the NT Recovery Version. Furthermore, some of the students are being transitioned into the homes for more fellowship and enjoyment of Christ.

In order to continue to bring more seeking students into the church life, the students and the team have begun prayer to begin a campus club at McGill University for the fall semester. This would allow the students access to rooms for Bible studies, as well as occasion multiple opportunities to preach the gospel to their fellow classmates through tract and Bible distributions. Please pray for the drafting of the club's constitution and that we would find favour in the eyes of the club administrators to start the club in September.

For the summer schedule, many students will still be in Montreal during the summer, and this is an excellent time for them to be invited by the saints for dinner and sweet fellowship

in all the homes (many speak both English & Chinese, and French as well). In addition, many students have expressed interest in attending the Midwest summer college training in July. This is a week-long training specifically for college students to train them in their character, study of the truth, and enjoyment of the Lord.
