## **Update on French-Speaking Church Life**

For the past three months, we have regularly had ten to twelve people in the Friday group meetings. However, although we do have some new ones who sometimes attend the meetings, we don't have any who is meeting regularly. We must desperately pray for the multiplication in numbers with remaining fruit.

We are considering multiplying into two groups for the Friday meetings, one in the East and the other in the central region. We want to maintain one prayer meeting, which would facilitate blending between the two future groups.

We have recently started a rotation of homes for the Friday meetings. This helps more homes to serve as hosts for the group meetings, and to receive the corresponding blessing. Moreover, we believe that this practice will help prepare us for a future multiplication into two groups.

We want to blend more with groups in other languages; we have already done this once with a Chinese-speaking group. We want to plan to blend more regularly.

We are almost finished with reading *The Glorious Church*. This reading has taken us many months. The reading became

somewhat sterile, but in the last few weeks, we started to read the portion during the week before the meeting. This practice very much enriches our sharing and enjoyment when we meet together. We plan to move on next to *The All-Inclusive Christ*.

On Tuesdays, we have the prayer meeting from 7:30 pm. We usually begin with one or two songs, or a little prayreading. Then we pray the items on the list in the newsletter; we also add other burdens as the Lord leads us. This usually brings us to 9 pm. For the remaining 30 minutes until 9:30, we have fellowship, coordination and prayers in view of practicing the vital group fellowship. This fellowship time very much helps our coordination, and gives us the sense that we are a team labouring together.

In addition, after praying and having some fellowship, we have started producing a CD of French hymns and songs. We hope that the CD would help saints enjoy the Lord more, and that during the production process the participating saints would be blended together. Up till now, we have only had one practice session, but we hope to have another session soon.
