## Update on the Spanish-Speaking Church Life

The following are prayers burdens and fellowship for the Spanish speaking saints:

1) Brother John S. has been at home since last Friday June 3; he will go to the hospital only for chemo treatment; he was released from the hospital because a change of environment might help him to recover faster. He got a second treatment which was stronger than the first one. He is not able to eat solid food yet. 4) Brother Ivan O.'s consecration of his new home for Christ and the Church, to be able to open his home for meetings, blending and mingling for the Lord's testimony in Montreal (West Island).

5) Sister Claudia needs to be recovered back to the church life. She is 24 years old from El Salvador. She works in Montreal as a nanny. We need a sister or sisters to contact her. (Ask Luis for contact information). Sister Maria has contacted her before.

## Update on the Korean-Speaking Church Life

We are not meeting regularly, but we are praying for more blending time between the two Korean-speaking families. Our

main burden is full salvation of our households and for sister Bosim's work permit.


