## Update on Saints Serving Full-Time

On the brothers on the campus team have been meeting with three students regularly. One student from Concordia is a contact from the January 2010 distribution. We have been sharing with him in the Word and started to pray-read the Word. We met two other students, one from Concordia and one from McGill, in the January 2011 BfC distribution. Both of them are believers; we read the Recovery Version with them, and help them to enjoy the word through pray-reading and touching their spirit. We also encourage them to speak and share about what they have enjoyed. We pray for their growth in life and that they will be preserved.

The sisters have been meeting regularly with two students from Concordia. They were contacted in January 2011 through the BfC distribution at Concordia. One is a believer and very much enjoys our times together, always sharing what she appreciated from the Word. The other is not yet a believer, but she also enjoys getting together to read the Bible and appreciates what it says. We trust that the Lord is sowing something into her each time we meet, and that eventually, she will believe in her heart and confess with her mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord. There is also another contact who has been meeting with a few sisters recently. She is a colleague of one of the sisters from McGill and is a believer.

There is a weekly college meeting on Wednesday night at the sisters' house, where the college students gather together to enjoy the Lord through singing, sharing experiences of Him, and reading a portion from the Life-Study of Genesis. Each week has been a time of mutual encouragement and building up.

This summer, a few of the college students will be attending the college training in Fairborn, OH (July 18-24), which will be a good opportunity to blend with saints from other localities and be infused with the Lord's speaking.
