Pray for:

- France: that four key families in Lyon might obtain stable financial situations for the sake of the church life; in particular, that one leading brother in Lyon might rapidly obtain a stable job (or else leave France); stable immigration situations for migrating saints and students; strengthening of nascent churches in Dieppe, Lille and Bordeaux; shepherding of contacts and raising up of churches in other places.
- West Indies: Strengthening of saints and churches throughout these islands; raising up of a strong testimony in Trinidad and Tobago; gaining of students at the University of the West Indies (campuses in Trinidad and Tobago, Jamaica and Barbados).
- The perfecting training on September 3-4. Encourage college students, young people, young working saints, families, and burdening ones to attend.
- Children in Montreal: that they would continue to grow in the church life in a proper way, including in their character training; that their parents have grace and wisdom, knowing how to nourish and cherish their children in love in view of God's economy; the Lord's grace in arranging the children's service, with a healthy coordination between parents and serving ones.
- That we might be granted an official club at McGill University; preparation for Bible distribution and seminar at Concordia and McGill in the first week of school.
- Renovation of meeting hall in Montreal, especially the roof, including the financial need for the renovation. The target is \$110,000 for phase 1 including roof and interior repair. The offering to date is \$86,000. We are still short of \$24,000.
- A planned conference at Fredericton, N.B. in the Canadian Thanksgiving weekend for blending and shepherding the new contacts from the gospel trip in August
- Pray for various local needs, including saints in Montreal, contacts, and those in need of care and shepherding.
