Pray for:

Update on the French-speaking church life

- We remain in contact with some new ones, but we are currently unable to follow up on all the new contacts from the last Bible seminar we had in August. However, some of us recently went to the Université de Montréal to contact students, and we distributed tracts and Bibles. We would like to go there again. There are also some Concordia students who received a French Bible during the distribution in September who requested follow up in a Bible study. We pray that the habit of contacting Frenchspeaking students would be cultivated among us. We must pray earnestly for the multiplication in number with remaining fruit. We pray that the Lord would increase our capacity to shepherd contacts and to raise them up in the divine life.
- As we mentioned before, we want to multiply into two groups for the Friday meetings, one in the East and the other in the central region. We are currently having fellowship on how to go about this, but we expect that the multiplication will take place soon. We want to keep a single prayer meeting, which will facilitate the blending between the two future groups.
- We want to blend more with groups in other languages; we have already done this once with a Chinese-speaking and once with an English-speaking group. We want to plan to blend more regularly.
- On Fridays we read *The All-Inclusive Christ.* Sometimes contacts in Quebec City join us by Skype. Although it is not as intimate as being there in person, this facilitates a genuine blending and building up.

- We have some contacts in Quebec City whom we go visit sometimes. We pray that the Lord would abound His grace to them and strengthen His move in that city.
- We have several homes open to meetings in NDG, downtown and in the East. June also wants to open her house, but this would probably be for informal, human gatherings, rather than for formal meetings. We pray that the Lord would lead us on to live a normal church life in our homes.
- Aaron and Phoebe will get married soon, which will add another married couple among the French-speaking saints. We pray for the preparations for their marriage and that these preparations would enable more blending among the saints.
- The new church website is currently being translated into French. This work is very strategic to have farther-reaching contact. Since we updated the English website (www.churchinmontreal.org) last year, we have had many English-speaking contacts through the website. We pray that the same thing would happen when we update the new French version.


