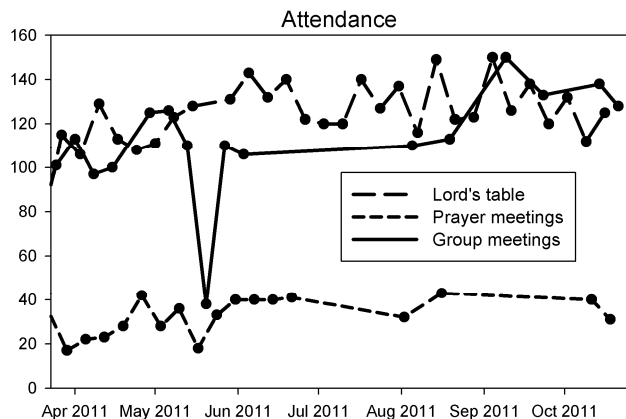

Update on Chinese-speaking saints

Through much prayer and fellowship, in the middle of September 2011, the Chinese-speaking saints increased to two districts in the prophesying meeting on Lord's day. The result and impact has been very positive for both districts. The total number of attendants is around 65, which is similar to before. However, the number of prophesying saints doubled after the increase of districts. Every Lord's day there were more than 30 saints prophesying in two districts, the participation rate is consistently around 50%. We have seen many silent saints starting to prophesy, all the saints prepared well for prophesying. The prophesying is increasing both in quantity and in quality. In order to create the opportunity for more saints to prophesy, we need to limit the time. Bro. Lee emphasized three minutes prophesying. We need to train the saints to prophesy precisely and concisely but not in a legal way. We are so encouraged that the prophesying burden is not just on a few saints' shoulders, but is shared by all the saints. We want to focus more on a prophesying life, especially the morning revival. The burden of morning revival needs to be promoted in the groups. Prophesying is a warfare, and so we will have more prayer together, especially for the preparation.

Special burdens:

- We are planning small group gospel preaching before the end of the year, and we will also have gospel preaching the

beginning of next year in the two Chinese-speaking districts respectively.

- Open our homes and strengthen the small group meetings, which should be less than three to four families for each meeting. This is the best way to preach gospel, to shepherd, to take care one another in organic way.
- It is very important to join in one another's daily living. We need more organic connections, such as having dinner on a small scale, reading the Bible at home, praying for our situations together in a home environment. Related to this, the function of sisters in home meetings is so important.
- We cannot preach gospel every week in the church meetings; however, we can do it in the home meetings. We need to bear remaining fruit. According to the life way, a baby needs to be born in a family, then needs to be nourished and taken care of in the family. We need to cherish and look after the gospel friends and new born ones. A lot of new born saints disappear because we didn't treat them as our family members. It is not God's ordained way to focus on big church gospel meetings; those meetings are for strengthening and creating a kind of atmosphere of the gospel. We need to strengthen the testimony in the small group meeting. If we don't have gospel friends in the group meetings, they will gradually lose their vitality.
- We also need to go to the saints' homes to visit and shepherd them. If 1/3 of the Chinese-speaking saints can go out in groups of two, there will be ten groups visiting saints every week. This will make the church life totally different. We need more fellowship on this matter.
