Please pray:

- Children: that the children of Montreal would grow up to love the Lord and love the church life; for the regeneration of every one of our children, especially before entering secondary school; that their parents might be genuine priests to bring their children to God and bring God to their children; that the serving ones might be burdened to pray for their priesthood and serve the children with a personal service; that the Lord might stir sisters up for the practice of neighbourhood children's meetings.
- Nepal earthquake: the Lord's grace and comfort to the families and friends of the thousands of people who lost their lives; rapid completion and distribution of the Rhema booklets in Nepalese, that many people might be saved and comforted through them; food, water and other needs for saints in the churches affected by the earthquake.
- Districts in Montreal: that the Lord might lead us as He multiplies us into various district meetings; for a clear and controlling vision of the oneness of the Body of Christ; genuine blending between the saints in the districts regardless of language; the Lord's burden and blessing for the propagation of the gospel of the kingdom in each of our neighbourhoods; a way to provide proper spiritual care for our children in the districts.
- Renovations: completion of the work to maintain and improve our meeting hall; fellowship and building up of saints through the labour of renovation; financial provision for the renovations.
- Translation of French hymns: that many more hymns might be translated into French for the sake of a richer Lord's table meeting for all the languages in the church, and for an increased enjoyment of the riches in Christ through the hymns by the French-speaking saints.
- Pray for various local needs, including saints in Montreal, contacts, and those in need of care and shepherding.

Announcements

For the next two weeks, instead of a regular HWMR book, we will get into the Bible text of Ephesians with the help of the life-study messages:

- May 11-17: Read and pray-read Ephesians chapters 1 to 3 (half a chapter per day), and read Life-Study of Ephesians messages 1 and 2.
- May 18-24: Read and pray-read Ephesians chapters 4 to 6 (half a chapter per day), and read Life-Study of Ephesians messages 3 and 4.

After that, we will resume a regular HWMR reading schedule, but the church will then continue to read one message of the Life-Study of Ephesians each week until we complete the entire life-study.

- On April 25, a major earthquake killed over 7,000 people in Nepal and injured many more. Among the saints meeting with the local churches in Nepal, none of the saints was killed or injured. Unfortunately, a Chinese brother on vacation was killed. Although physically safe, many saints in the churches suffered damage to their homes, and many are in urgent need of food, water and other supplies because of the extensive damage caused. Please pray for the comfort and supply of the saints and for the Nepalese people. If the Lord leads you to contribute to the saints' need, please designate your offering as "Nepal earthquake relief" (but note that there can be no tax receipt for such external donations).
- The saints in the church are being grouped into three districts (North-West, South-East and Central) according to geography (not language) for prayer, building up, church services, and receiving the Lord's burden for gaining remaining fruit and shepherding contacts in all languages. The boundaries for the districts should not be taken as legal requirements; be free to follow the Lord as He leads you in the fellowship of the Body. Based on where you live, the general boundaries for the districts are:
 - West: Montreal Island west of Highway 13 or 32nd Avenue in Lachine
 - o East: Montreal Island east of Saint-Laurent Boulevard
 - North: Montreal Island north of Highway 40 in between Highway 13 and Saint-Laurent Boulevard; and all of Laval
 - o South: South Shore
 - Central: Montreal Island in between Highway 13/32nd
 Avenue and Saint-Laurent Boulevard, south of Highway 40 and north of the Saint Lawrence River



Scripture Reading: Exo. 10:8-11, 21-26; 12:6-11, 37-42; 2 Cor. 6:17

II. AREAS THAT REQUIRE SEPARATION FROM THE WORLD (continued)

B. Things Incompatible with the Lord

Anything that is incompatible with the Lord must also be removed. Since the Lord suffered humiliation on the earth, we should not seek glory here. Since the Lord was crucified like a robber, we should not seek to be welcomed everywhere. When our Lord was walking on the earth, He was accused of demon possession. We cannot allow people to say that we have the best mind, that we are smart, or that we are very intellectual. We have to pass through what the Lord passed through. Everything that is incompatible with the Lord must go.

The Lord said that a slave is not greater than his master and a disciple is not greater than his teacher. If the world treated our Master one way, we should not expect it to treat us another way. If it treated our Teacher one way, we should not expect it to treat us another way. If we are not treated the same as our Master, something is wrong with us, and something is definitely wrong in our relationship with the Lord. Whatever our Lord experienced on the earth should be our experience today.
