

Please pray:

- ✿ Increase in life and numbers: that the saints would grow in life, love and truth so that Christ would be the real content of the church; that we would be burdened to care for saints and contacts who do not meet regularly by visiting them or inviting them to our homes; that we would be burdened to contact our family members, friends, neighbours, colleagues and random people whom the Lord brings our way and shepherd them into the church life.
- ✿ Canada: Increase in life, truth, and numbers in all the churches; visitation and genuine blending among the churches throughout the country; perfecting of more brothers with pure and absolute hearts to take the lead as the Lord moves and spreads; mass distribution of literature through Bibles for Canada and the labour of saints and churches; gaining and shepherding of contacts and raising up churches in every province and territory; gaining and shepherding students in the colleges and universities; migration to establish and strengthen new and smaller churches; that Canada be filled with shining golden lampstands from sea to sea to sea to maintain the genuine testimony of Jesus.
- ✿ Senior coworkers in the Lord's recovery: that the Lord would keep them strong and healthy in spirit, soul and body as they take the lead in the Lord's move; for the health of many older brothers and that of their family members; that the Lord would continue to mature and perfect many saints to take the way of ministry to become genuine ministers of the new covenant for the building up and going on of the churches.
- ✿ GTCA Laval: that key homes would be gained in Laval for the Lord's testimony; that saints in Montreal would be burdened to continue shepherding the contacts; for remaining fruit for the practical building up of the Body of Christ.
- ✿ Middle Eastern migrants in Europe: gospel trips in Germany from January to July; grace to the churches in Germany, including saints who are migrating there for this burden; the free mass distribution of care packages and literature; the shepherding of the seeking ones; the participation of brothers and sisters with an adequate knowledge of the truth and a proficiency in the Arabic and Farsi languages; the salvation and gaining of the Lord's chosen ones, both native Germans and Middle Eastern migrants, and their continued shepherding so that they may be remaining fruit for the churches; the Lord's protection of His present move from the attack of the evil one; the financial provision for this move.

- ✿ Pray for various local needs, including saints in Montreal, contacts, and those in need of care and shepherding.

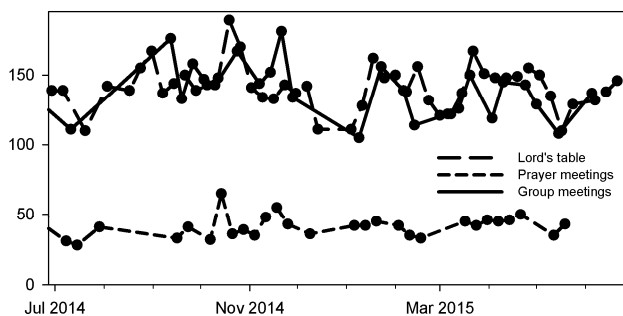

CONSECRATION

Scripture Reading: Exo. 28:1-2, 40-41; 29:1-25; Lev. 8:14-28; Rom. 6:13, 16, 19; 12:1; 1 Cor. 6:19-20; 2 Cor. 5:14-15

V. THE GOAL OF CONSECRATION

The goal of consecration is not to become a preacher for God or to work for Him. The goal of consecration is to serve Him. The result of consecration is service. In the original language the word service means "to wait upon." This means that a person is prepared to serve. We must remember that the goal of consecration is to wait upon God. Waiting upon someone may not be strenuous work. To wait upon God means that you stand when He wants you to stand. If He wants to shuffle you aside, you allow Him to shuffle you aside, and if He wants you to run, you run. This is what it means to wait on Him.

God requires that all Christians offer up their bodies to wait on Him. This does not necessarily mean that He wants you to stand at the pulpit or evangelize some remote land. It means to wait on God. If God sends someone to the pulpit, that person has no choice but to speak. If God sends someone to remote lands, he has no choice but to go. All our time is for God, but the work that we do is flexible. Everyone should wait on God, but the specific work that one should engage in is flexible. We must learn to wait on God. The presenting of one's body is for serving God.
